Our volunteer Design Review Committee (DRC) has been working the past several months on the creation of the TrailMark Shed/Greenhouse and Outdoor Structure Policy. This policy is for the 659 single family homes, not the Star Canyon Patio Homes or Condos.

At the HOA meeting on March 11th, the Board unanimously voted to adopt and approve the new policy effective immediately.

If you wish to install a shed, greenhouse or outdoor structure, please review this policy prior to submitting your DRC Home Improvement Request form.

Accessory Buildings Sheds and Greenhouses Policy

Kindly remember that all sheds, greenhouses and outdoor structures REQUIRE written DRC approval prior to commencing your project.

The Board wishes to thank the DRC for all of their time and effort in creating this policy.

Filing 3 HOA/TMMD Fence Painting and Maintenance

The TrailMark HOA and the TrailMark Metro District (TMMD) will be starting the annual split rail fence painting and maintenance. This year they will be working on Filing 3 (please refer to map below).

For those of you who don't know, Filing 3 is in the very southwest corner of TrailMark and includes the Star Canyon Patio Homes and Condos.

This past month, members of the HOA and TMMD started marking broken posts and rails with white X's. The marked posts and rails will be replaced prior to painting.

As a friendly reminder to those of you who have chicken wire installed to keep your pets inside of your yard, the

chicken wire should be installed on the inside of the split rail fence in your own yard and not on the outside of the split rail fence. Now is a good time to relocate your chicken wire if it's on the outside.

This is a huge filing and it will take several weeks to fix the posts and rails, as well as paint the split rail fence. Again, we wanted to alert all of you in Filing 3 that if you see crews working on the split rail fence, they've been hired to do so.

Last year many of you were kind and gave drinks and snacks to the contractors. This is definitely not necessary, but very much appreciated! It just shows how great our neighborhood is.

Sadly, some vandals thought it would be fun to destroy TrailMark Park, as someone pulled the dog waste bag sign out of the ground and left it for folks to trip over while walking the trails. This is now the second reported incident of vandalism at TrailMark Park in the past month. HOA President Ken Colaizzi was able to put the sign back into the ground until SSPR could fix it.

Most homeowners of the 799 homes here in TrailMark don't think it's cool or funny to destroy private property. In fact, through our property taxes, we each pay hundreds of dollars a year to South Suburban Parks and Rec (SSPR) to help maintain our parks.

If vandalism continues, the SSPR mill levy will most likely rise in the near future which will end up costing all of us more money. Our community is calling on our fellow neighbors to please be vigilant.

If you see suspicious activity, destructive behavior, or someone vandalizing our parks, please report it to the SSPR Ranger at 303-435-8227. The Ranger is on call 24/7/365. You may also report it to Littleton Police at 303-794-1551.

Being willing to speak up is beneficial to all of us because it helps eliminate vandalism, keeps our parks safe for our children, and helps keep our property taxes down. If you see something, say something.
