We at South Metro Fire Rescue invite you to participate in our annual Citizens Academy. This 10-week academy is a rare opportunity to discover the mysteries of modern firefighting and learn priceless life-saving skills. You'll learn about South Metro Fire Rescue from behind the scenes and learn about yourself and your community in the process.

All classes are on Thursdays from 6-10 p.m. Each of the ten classes is taught or facilitated by SMFR personnel. Here is a summary of the current schedule:

Locations vary depending on the topic. Attendance is critical to your success in the program so participants are expected to attend every class.

There is a \$30 participation fee, but financial aid may be available if needed.

Participants perform physically-challenging activities such as rappelling, crawling, and performing CPR on mannikins. While we won't exclude candidates based on physical abilities, we want to be transparent about the nature of the activities.
