

The Altogether Recycling ™ program is the most comprehensive recycling program available. Here is a list of the items that are accepted and can be mixed "Altogether" in one container:

- Aluminum (don't crush)
- Brown Paper Bags
- Bulk/Junk Mail
- Chipboard
- Corrugated Cardboard
- Detergent Bottles (Tide)
- Empty Aerosol Cans
- Glass Bottles/Jars
- Magazines
- Milk/Juice Cartons
- Mixed Paper
- Newspaper/Inserts

- Office Paper
- Phonebooks
- Plastics #1-#7 & rigid
- Plastic Milk Jugs
- Styrofoam
- Tin Cans

You No Longer Have to Sort

To prepare your items to be recycled, please make sure to remove as much of the food residue and liquid as possible. In addition, please make sure there are **NO PLASTIC BAGS** mixed in your recyclables.

Here are some more helpful hints for recycling:

Aluminum or Tin Cans ONLY - Please do not crush the cans and make sure any aerosol cans are completely empty. Examples: Shaving cream and hairspray cans. Labels left on cans are okay.

Bags - Brown paper bags are acceptable, but please **NO PLASTIC BAGS**. They could potentially get stuck in the conveyor belts and shut down the entire operation while we try to locate the jam.

Bulk/Junk Mail - If you can tear it, we can take it! Don't worry about removing stamps, staples, or sticky notes. NO TYVEK plastic mailing folders.

Cardboard – Please FLATTEN BOXES! No waxed lined cardboard is accepted in the recycling mix, but it can be composted.

Chip or Paperboard—Please FLATTEN chip and paperboard. Examples: Cereal boxes, soda carrier boxes, tissue boxes, paper towel/toilet paper tubes and microwave food boxes.

Magazines, Newspapers and Phone Books - Please discard plastic bags around these items, as well as CDs and magnet.

Office Paper – Again, if you can tear it, we can take it. All types of office paper are accepted, and colored paper is fine. No need to remove staples, paperclips, tape or sticky notes. **NO SHREDDED PAPER!**

Styrofoam – Packing type foam or Styrofoam are accepted, but please **NO PACKING PEANUTS!**



Plastic – Generally, we accept rigid plastics and plastics #1-#7. You may leave plastic lids and caps on the containers, but if there is a pump, please remove. MOST IMPORTANTLY, remove as much food debris and liquid as possible from the containers. If you are able to give them a quick rinse, even better!

Accepted Plastics:

- Pop, water and juice bottles
- Liquid detergent and other cleaning supply bottles
- Condiment bottles (ketchup, mustard, etc)
- Milk and juice jugs and cartons
- Shampoo/Conditioner bottles and liquid soap dispensers (remove pumps)
- Peanut butter jars (rinsed out)
- Butter and Yogurt Tubs
- Large Toys (no metal or wheels)
- Plastic lawn furniture
- Plastic buckets (remove metal handles)

Plastic items **NOT** accepted:

- No clamshell or "to go" plastic food containers
- No plastic plates, forks, spoons or knives
- No #7 PLA compostable containers
- No six pack holders
- No plastic syringes (needles)

We absolutely CANNOT accept the following:

- NO HAZARDOUS OR BIO-HAZARDOUS WASTE PRODUCTS.
- NO USED MOTOR OIL PLASTIC BOTTLES OR PETICIDE PLASTIC BOTTLES.
- NO CERAMICS OR PYREX CONTAINERS.
- NO WINDSHIELD, WINDOW OR PICTURE FRAME GLASS.
- NO USED PAPERTOWELS, NAPKINS OR TISSUES.
