There is also 1- two year term with only one candidate.

There is also a ballot question regarding the reinstatement of term limits for the TMMD Board of Directors.

According to the Colorado State Constitution, term limits are defined as serving a maximum of 2-4 year terms. In the early years of the District, there was a vote to remove term limits. In other words, the Board of Directors could serve more than TWO 4-year terms. This year the ballot includes a question asking voters if they want to return the TWO 4-year term limits to Board positions. A "yes" vote is for term limits, a "no" vote is not to have term limits.

Shall the limitations on terms of office contained in Article XVII, Section 11 of the Colorado Constitution be reinstated as applied to terms of office for the directors of the TrailMark Metropolitan District?
